

# Amended Rules for ACDF Visitation In-Person

The Sheriff's Office has modified the reopening of in-person visitation for inmates at the Arlington County Detention Center. Relatives and friends will regain the ability to visit incarcerated loved ones in person beginning May 1, 2021. Please see the below information to ensure you are aware of the modifications made to visitation.

1. (1) Pre-scheduled in-person visit will be held on Saturdays or Sundays from 9:00am – 6:00pm. (1 visit per month). Please see schedule to determine the week you are eligible.

2. The incarcerated individual will schedule all visits. They will be allowed to complete an in-person visiting request form. Visiting days will be determined by a housing unit schedule posted in their housing unit.
3. The visit is scheduled for 60 minutes
4. Sheriff Office Staff will contact visitors prior to the day of visiting to confirm the visit's been scheduled.
5. All visitors should arrive at a minimum of 15 minutes before their scheduled visit for processing. If you do not arrive a minimum of 15 minutes early, there will be no guarantee that you will receive the full 60-minute visit. Also be aware that late visitors will not get a full 60-minute visit, all visits will end at the same time.
6. All visitors must wear a face covering for the duration of the time inside of the detention facility. If you do not have a face covering, you will not be permitted to visit.
7. No more than 2 adults (18 years or older, Photo ID required) will be permitted to visit at a time per inmate.
8. All visitors will be asked COVID-19 related questions and have their temperature taken.
9. All visitors are subject to search of their persons and belongings.

10. All visitors are prohibited from bringing in any item that is considered dangerous or presents a potential threat to the safety and security of the ACDF.
11. All personal items must be stored in the public lockers (you will need quarters) or to secure your items in your vehicle. Lobby staff will not store or hold items at the desk.
12. Inmates housed in a quarantine housing unit will not be permitted in-person visits until they have completed their quarantine period.
13. Visitors must be appropriately attired, to include shoes. *The following dress is prohibited: sheer or see-through material, midriff, tube/tank tops, miniskirts. You may not be allowed to visit if staff determine that you are not dressed appropriately.*
14. The Arlington County Sheriff's Office reserves the right to deny person's access into the building for known past violations of Facility rules and regulations. Any person released from the ACDF within the past 30 days is not eligible to visit.
15. Excessive Noise or harassing/abusive language is not permitted. Those found to be in violation of these rules will be asked to leave.
16. Visitors are prohibited from bringing drugs or alcohol or to be under the influence of drugs or alcohol in the ACDF. Persons found to be in the possession of OR under the influence of drugs or alcohol are subject to arrest.
17. Any visitor found to be attempting to introduce contraband into the ACDF or engaging in any other conduct which is in violation of the law (including but not limited to, actions which assist in escape, possession of escape paraphernalia, or inducing a riot) may be arrested.
